Together with a selected student CityU and another from HKUST, the Joint Student Team was formed.

With the additional efforts from the team trainers and further coaching from our very devoted members of the Panel of Judges, the China HKASR Joint Team won the 2nd Prize in the Student Competition on 13<sup>th</sup> September in London.

Congratulations to the students of the Joint University Team. Many thanks to the support from the universities, Team Coach/Trainer, Dr C K CHUI and Mr Sidhant GUPTA from HKU, and the Panel of Judges led by Ir Dr Andrew CHAN for their time and support to HKAES in competing in such a meaningful event.

# **4 HKAES Beijing Visit** (17<sup>th</sup>~19<sup>th</sup> November 2019)

Past President Ir Prof Joseph Lee, Hon Secretary Ir Dr Alex Chan, Hon Treasurer Ir Prof Alfonso Ngan and I visited Beijing and met the Chinese Academy of Engineering, the Guanghua Engineering Science and Technology Award Foundation, the Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST) and the China Association of Science and Technology (CAST) on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> November. Senior Vice President Ir Dr Otto Poon was initially with the team but was not able to join due to some unforeseen circumstances.

We visited CAE in the morning of Nov 18 and were received by Vice President Wang of CAE. We had a fruitful discussion on strengthening our future collaboration and cooperation, particularly on forming university student teams in competing for the Global Grand Challenges Summit Awards. We have also touched base on organizing the second CAE-HKAES Technology Forum in 2020 (the first joint forum was held in 2015).

After the CAE meeting, we visited the Guanghua Engineering Science and Technology Award Foundation. We had a thorough exchange on the process of selecting and nominating qualified candidates in Hong Kong SAR by HKAES. We had also discussed the possibility of hosting an official award ceremony in Hong Kong to raise the profile of the Award.

After lunch, we visited MOST and were introduced by various officials of the Ministry on the strategic planning and development of science and technology in China. There was also an exchange on how to engage our fellows to participate in formulating roadmap and project definition on certain strategic scientific and technological areas. We were also told that Hong Kong would have an important role to play in promoting engineering and technology development in Greater Bay Area. Joseph left Beijing after the visit to MOST.

We visited CAST on morning of Tuesday, Nov 19. We were received by the Executive Secretary together with his colleagues from various departments. We had an extensive dialogue on how to promote institutional collaboration on different fronts, particularly on STEM education and ways to raise the awareness of science and technology to the general public.



## 6 Other Activities

### a. Joint Breakfast Meetings

HKAES, in cooperation with the Hong Kong Academy of Sciences (ASHK), Hong Kong Institute of Sciences (HKSI) and the Hong Kong Federation of Industries (FHKI) have been organising joint breakfast meetings four times every year. Officials from the Hong Kong SAR Government were invited to be the Guests of Honours. The purpose of the meeting is to update the latest development on policies and related activities in Hong Kong and the Greater Bay Areas on technology, innovation, incubation and industry activities.
